
## Author Visits Make Reading and Writing Exciting!




- Presentations last approximately 45 minutes (30 mins. for K-1 students) with additional time for questions at the end.

The Kentucky frontier was a beautiful place, but a dangerous one. In July 1776, Jemima Boone and two friends were kidnapped. This is the story of courage, imagination, and unbeatable determination. Learn about frontier history and how an author does research. Grades 3-8.



*Storm Warning* is historical fiction based on the Red River flood of 1997. When twelve-year-old North is left in charge, a blizzard blows. Can he save his sister and injured great-grandmother and also win Dad's approval? Learn how the author's experiences led her write to this novel. Students learn how they can do this, too. For grades 3-6.
